IDENTIFY A FAMILY MEMBER OR TRUSTED FRIEND WHO CAN HELP YOU VOTE IF YOU NEED ASSISTANCE.

However, the laws states that no single person can assist more than one voter with a disability on Election Day.

TAKE YOUR VOTER'S IDENTIFICATION CARD WITH YOU TO THE POLLING STATION TO FACILITATE THE **IDENTIFICATION PROCESS.**

If you are unable to locate vour voter identification card. vou will still be allowed to vote after taking an oath and answering some questions.

AFTER VOTING, DIP YOUR RIGHT INDEX FINGER IN THE

INK. If you are missing your right index finger, the Presiding Officer will indicate which finger you should dip into the ink instead. You then leave the polling station.



WEAR YOUR MASK

and adhere to all relevant COVID-19 protocols.



FOLLOW ALL LEGAL INSTRUCTIONS given by the Presiding Officer

at the Polling Station.



DO NOT use your cellular phone

inside the polling station.



DO NOT show anvone inside the
