

# THE CHILDREN REFERENDUM SATURDAY NOVEMBER 10TH






EASY-TO-READ GUIDE

On Saturday November 10<sup>th</sup> you will be asked to vote in a referendum.



A **referendum** is a time when you vote to change a part of the constitution of Ireland.

The **Constitution** of Ireland sets out the rules of the Country.

All citizens must obey these rules.



This referendum is about the rights of children in Ireland.



You will be asked to vote Yes or No.

Vote Yes if you agree with the changes.

Vote No if you want the constitution to stay the same.

### nere are 4 main parts of information about the aggested change to the Constitution.



 The State will recognise that children have rights.
 The State must support and protect the rights of children.

**The State** = The government

Sometimes a child's parents may not provide enough care to keep the child safe.

If this happens the State will get involved and help. This will happen if a child's parents are married or unmarried.



3. When parents have failed over a period of time to look after the child and keep the child safe:

The State may decide that it is best for another family to **adopt** the child.

This means the child will live with new parents all of the time.

The State will only do this if it is the best decision for the child.



4. The judges in the courts will listen to the opinions of the child when a decision is being made about that child.


